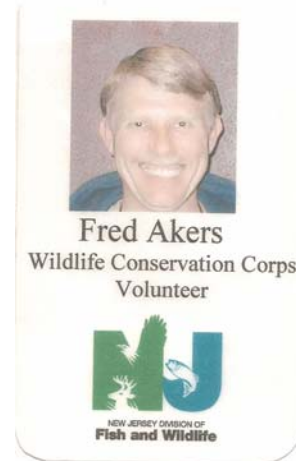


# Barred Owl Sighting Report

A barred Owl was heard calling from this site on 6/9/06. This owl called four times in a few minutes around 10pm. The listening position was near the old dug pond on the Sahara Sands mining site, and the calling location was approximately 1000 feet away in the White Oak Branch wetlands. The call was the characteristic “who-cooks-for-you-who-cooks-for-you” that was repeated four times, one right after the next. MAP 1 illustrates the approximate listening and calling locations.
